OUTDOOR WOOD

Iroko wood originates in Africa. It grows in equatorial forests and is inherently highly resistant to changes in temperature, humidity and weather conditions, thus making it absolutely perfect for use in outdoor settings. Iroko is variegated in color and, depending on its maturity, ranges from yellow to dark brown. Iroko is a fairly stable type of wood (minimal shrinkage and swelling when exposed to humidity) and solid Iroko is further stabilized in special drying kilns. Simple to work and cut, it lends itself easily to processes like gluing and assembly.

Care: iroko is absolutely ideal for outdoor use in all kinds of weather and requires a modest amount of care. Clean daily with a soft cloth, dampened with water, and pH-neutral liquid soap. With the passage of time, untreated iroko tends to take on a grey hue due to exposure to the sun and/or rain. Iroko is naturally protected by its own oils that waterproof its surface. Depending on the climate and, in any case, at least twice a year or more often, it is important to clean the product with a pH-neutral detergent; then, lightly sand the surface with fine grain sandpaper; then use a brush to apply, by hand, a coat of wax-effect, water-based protective finish.
