


## MATT CALACATTA ORO

Calacatta Oro is marble quarried in the Apuan Alps (Carrara marble). Although it has the same origins as Carrara (typically white), its color tends toward ivory/butter and has prominent veins, ranging from gold to shades of brown, green and gray. The vein pattern varies throughout the slabs and thus it is possible to have parts with distinct veining and others with large areas of white, creating an interesting cobblestone-like pattern very popular in the production of tables and cladding for bathrooms. Since Calacatta Oro is a sedimentary sandstone marble, it contains various types of randomly distributed crystals and gray pebbles that are a specific feature of this kind of marble. To properly care for marble, we recommend that spills from acidic liquids, such as soft drinks, alcohol, oil, wine, vinegar and citrus, be avoided if at all possible and, if they do occur, cleaned up immediately, so as not to damage the polish. To clean marble, use very mild products that do not contain thinners or corrosive substances.




